- ♦ **Swimbridge Parish Council** - the next meeting is on Tues 14 July, 7 for 7.30 pm at the Jubilee Hall.
- ♦ **Swimbridge Jubilee Hall** will be re-opening with restriction measures in place as from the 4th July. Each booking will be assessed on a case by case basis and a 1 metre social distancing rule in place. The hall is suitable for activities such as Slimming World with restricted numbers, craft classes for small numbers, etc. Unfortunately we are not yet able to take bookings for parties, weddings, etc, and the kitchen is currently not in use. As restrictions ease, we will open more facilities in line with Government guidelines. Hand gels, tissues and sprays are available for use at the entrance. **The Jubilee Hall foyer/meeting room is open from 10 am—5 pm daily. Only one household or one individual is permitted in the hall at any one time.** We are still taking non perishable foods and toiletries for Foodbank. However, as the hall is starting to reopen we are reducing the books/ puzzles to just one table. Therefore please do not leave any more items. The surplus has been taken to Over and Above (NHS) Charity shop.
- ♦ **Landkey Lyncroft Stores** have items in stock and are offering an excellent service. They have now stopped their delivery service. Please remember to keep supporting our local shops and businesses—they need you to survive.
