IMPORTANT NOTICE from the Jubilee Hall Committee — PLEASE READ

South West Water has a right of way through the village hall car park to access the village sewerage pumping station via the hall car park entrance next to the bus shelter. Over the past few months they have reverted back to using this right of way. The Hall Committee receives no advance warning of their visits as it is usually for emergencies, and access needs to be available 365 days pa 24/7.

Therefore please **DO NOT** park your car in the village hall car park unless you are visiting the Jubilee Hall as it is essential that SWW can inform vehicle owners to move their cars immediately. If the access is breached SWW will be unable to fix the breakdowns at the sewerage pumping station, which will affect us all.
